This time is designed to be spent not only in learning the ritual, which is daunting enough, but also in gaining an understanding, and developing the skills of **lodge management**. Many of us in our professional careers have participated in **Mid-Year** and **End of Year** review sessions. The reason these are so critical in the business world parallels within a masonic lodge. Any smart organization knows the strengths and weaknesses of it's employees. This holds true for masonry and its workman.

So, whether you're a Past Master or newly raised Master Mason I ask you these 6 questions:

- What are 2-3 ways you've contributed to your lodge in past 6 mths?
- What are 2-3 unique skills you bring to your lodge?
- What are 2-3 of your strengths?
- What are 2-3 ways you can help the lodge excel using your strengths?
- What are 2-3 weaknesses you have?
- What 3-4 actions **WILL** you take to strengthen your weak areas?

Identifying these attributes can be challenging. Ask a brother his opinion but be ready to accept his feedback. I challenge each of you to evaluate yourself and you will see growth manifest itself in your professional, social, & masonic life. This exercises fosters great leadership and the continued success of Six7.
